
If you enjoy wine, you probably love the taste of it. But for most people, the process of opening up a bottle of wine is equally as pleasurable. Sure, there are some folks who like to stick their noses into the neck and inhale deeply before taking in that vast bouquet; others like to pop open their cork in one swift movement; and yet others might only want to take an intermittent whiff over the course of many hours. No matter your preference, there's no denying that opening up a bottle is an enjoyable process — so much so that it would be quite sad if something went wrong at any point during this step. Fortunately, if you're looking for a fun way to get your hands on some new French wine, then this DIY wine bottle cork rack might just fit the bill. This charming DIY project can be done by several different means. If you have a lot of DIY skills and the ability to weld, then maybe you could create your very own cork holder out of metal instead of wood. If all you have are some cork-pulling skills but want to give this project a try, then you should take note that it's not nearly as difficult as it may seem at first glance. All it takes is a little bit of woodworking know-how, a stapler and a bit of elbow grease. If you're intrigued, then read on for the step-by-step instructions: Step 1: Gather your tools Start by gathering up all your materials. You'll need one piece of wood for the base, 4 pieces of wood for the sides and either some small nails or some heavy duty staples with a stapler. You also need a large cork to use as your rack's main attraction. Make sure that you pick something that's going to fit in each section you've decided on — in most cases, a standard size cork will do just fine. Step 2: Mark your lines Once you have everything you need, all you have to do is get started. First of all, take your one piece of wood and measure out a 3/4-inch line at the center. Use a pencil to mark the center point and then use a ruler or a straight edge to extend that line from one side of the board to the other. This way, you'll have a perfect spot for your cork. Step 3: Cut your lines Now that you've got your markings in place all you have to do is cut away the excess wood out from between those lines with any saw that will do the trick. It's important to remember that you don't want to saw too far inside the lines in fear of cutting your cork when it's placed into the center. When the lines are completely cut, sand them down until they're nice and smooth. Then you can attach your sides together using either some small nails or some heavy duty staples depending on how sturdy you want your cork holder to be. Step 4: Insert your cork Now that you've got your cork holder built, it's time to put in your cork for display. Simply place that bad boy into the center of your rack, then sit back and relax because that's all there is to do here.
